### Where Does My Money Go?

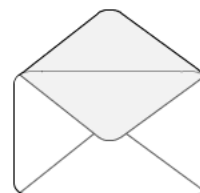
Your Elders consult annually with the Management Team to prayerfully consider the various ministries and needs within our church and elsewhere so that funds are invested for maximum spiritual growth. Monies allocated to Operations go to the upkeep of the facilities, support our pastoral staff and administration, enable the various ministries to function including Women’s, Men’s, Youth, Sunday School, and Kids For Christ. Plus we support at least a dozen missionary families and community-based organizations like The Pregnancy Health Centre.

While cash or cheques deposited in the offering plate are always appreciated, we encourage you to consider the following 4 options which may prove more convenient for you. All donations are eligible for an annual tax receipt.

#### 1, Numbered Offering Envelopes

We can supply dated and numbered envelopes for discreet giving in the offering plate.

#### 2. Pre-Approved Payment From Your Bank

This automates monthly or biweekly withdrawals from your bank account. This helps ensure you are giving consistently and regularly. You can easily review and adjust your ongoing donations as circumstances or income changes.
